

Dear Listener.

Thank you for sending word that you heard our new station W6XBE, the dolden Gate International Exposition international broadcasting station on Treasure Island in San Francisco Pay. Our acknowledgment cards are not yet ready, but we shall send one to you when they are available.

The schedule we are following is 3:30 to 7:00 p.m. PST, which will be primarily for Mexico, Central and South America, and 4:00 to 7:00 a.m. PST for listeners in the Grient.

Until further notice we shall operate only on 15,330 KC or 19.56 meters. Our amplifier is rated at 20,000 watts, radiating approximately 200,000 watts in the direction of South America in the afternoon and toward the Orient in the morning, using an Alexanderson 30° beam panel directional antenna.

As the purpose of thir station is to increase the goodvill between the United States and other countries, we want to broadcast programs that listeners want to hear. Therefore, we would appreciate any comments that are sent to us on any phase of our service.
