RADIO MOSCOW WINTER SCHEDULES

Radio Moscow changed to winter frequency schedules on October 20.

The North American Service moved to most of the usual 7 and 9 mhz winter frequencies, with a new frequency (for this service) of 9800 khz added.

The Sofia transmitter moved from 11710 to 9765, where there is severe QRM from the BBC Antigua relay on the Latin American Service.

The Central Asia transmitter moved from 9720 (listed as Kenga) to its usual winter frequency of 7440, but this frequency will probably be continued to be QSL'd as a Moscow site, which was done during the past several winter seasons.

The Havana relay moved from 9600 to 6115.

A new Petropavlovsk frequency of 21530 is being used to 0300 to W.NA, replacing 21565.

The best daytime World Service frequencies to E.NA are 17810 at 1100-1500, 15150 at 1230-1600, 11860 at 1600-2100 and 9685 at 1800-2300.

The Radio Kiev/Vilnius/Rodina programs are on a new frequency of 9750, plus the usual 7150 channel to 0200 (when it is transferred to Spanish for Mexico/Central America), and 7400 at 0200-0400.

Daytime World Service frequencies to W.NA are 5900 at 1300-1800, 7175 at 1300-1900, 7290 at 1300-2100, 7370 at 1300-1600, 9580 at 1700-1800 & 1900-2000 (Russian 1800-1900), 9795 at 1400-1700, 12050 at 1900-2300, 15455 at 2000-2300. (Doug Johnson, WA)

The Home Service 1st Program has been reorganized into five editions instead of the previous four. The main edition 0200-2200 remains unchanged, but the target area has been reduced. Orbita-1 seems to be 1855-1400, target area is Kamchatka, Magadan and Sakhalin provinces. Orbita 2 is on 2000-1600 for Primore, Khabarovsk, Amur and Chita provinces and Yakut ASSR. Orbita 3 is on 2200-1800 for Central Siberia (Novosibirsk-Irkutsk). Orbita 4 is for Central Asia, Westernmost Siberia and the Urals, at 0000-2000.

The Radiostantsiya Tikhly Okean (Radio Pacific Ocean) program, produced in Vladivostok, has retimed its morning program to 0815-0900, with relay of news 0800-0815. The 1930-2030 period remains at that time.

Radio Tashkent has added a new morning transmission, at 0230-0330, on 6025, 6155, 7335, 9600.
