TI4NRH - A Picture Gallery

In the world of shortwave broadcast history, Amando Céspedes Marín is well known as the founder of tiny (7.5 *watt*) Costa Rican shortwave station TI4NRH, which went on the air in 1928. Now the Costa Rican postal service has included him as one of three honorees on a "Legacy of Our Independence" stamp sheet issued in 2020 (the other two personages are a teacher and a suffragette). The sheet is shown below; Don Amando's stamp is the bottom one. To the right of it is a picture of a younger Don Amando as he appeared on a QSL issued by TI4NRH in 1936 (you can see the QSL in the clear here).



In 1931 Don Amando wrote a book about his station called "Me and Little Radio NRH." In 2006 I had access to a copy for a short period, and I wrote a review, which you can find here. Subsequently I was able to obtain two copies of my own, one in excellent condition that I am reluctant even to crack open, the other a "reading copy," whose binding may have provided nourishment to a small critter or two during its very rough life. But the folios are intact, and from them I have scanned the book's radio-related photos, which you can see below (they include, at the end, an inscription by Don Amando).







